### **Whole School Visit – Countryside Live at The Ledston Estate, Ledsham, Leeds**

This year, our whole school visit will be to the Countryside Live event on Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> May. It will be held on the beautiful Ledston Estate near Leeds. The event will be a country show with a central arena showing gundog, falconry and dog and duck displays throughout the day. There will be a large number of different interactive workshops that classes will attend such as felt making, meeting bats, bugs, animals and learning about plants.

The PTA are kindly contributing £500 towards the cost of the coaches and ask for a **contribution of £6 per child** to cover the cost of entry to the show (£4) and part of the coach cost. We ask that this is paid through Parent Pay. Please contact the office if you need a new password or any help with Parent Pay.

We will be leaving at 9am prompt and returning later than usual at 3:45pm. Please collect children from the school playground and not from Kingsland Terrace or en-route back to school.

Children are asked to wear their school t-shirts and jumpers (if chilly) but can wear their own 'bottoms' (no need for school trousers/skirts/dresses). **The children will be outside all day and should dress for the weather with suitable coats/shoes/hat. Sunscreen should be applied to children before they come to school** as we cannot take bottles of sunscreen with us. The organisers have recommended that anyone attending the visit (children and adults) **do not wear open toed footwear.**

Children will need to bring a packed lunch and two drinks. School can provide a packed lunch for children entitled to a free school meal. Children may like to bring an additional drink. **All children will need to carry their lunches around with them so a small light back pack would be useful.**

We would like some parent helpers on this visit although numbers will need to be limited. Please indicate below if you would like to be considered and we will let you know nearer the time. We cannot take younger children who are not at the school on this visit.

Please return the reply slip and pay contributions as soon as possible, but no later than **Friday 12<sup>th</sup> May**. If you have any questions, please get in touch.
