Family Picnic and Sports Day

This will take place on Friday 3rd July. As there will be no hot lunches served on this day, children are asked to bring a picnic lunch which they will eat outdoors. Children who are in FS/KS1 or are entitled to free school meals can have a free lunch provided by school if they wish. This will need to be ordered via the slip below.

Please arrive for the picnic between 12-12:10pm. We ask that during these times you come through the playground gates and collect your children from the classroom or from the area of the playground where they will be waiting with their teacher.

At 12:10pm we will be locking the playground gate so please come through the main entrance after this time.

As there is very little room in the car park, the gates will be closed from 11:40am so please walk or find alternative places to park.

The sporting events will start at 1:15pm and we anticipate they will finish just before 3pm. There will be the usual mixture of team games and races.

We ask that once the sporting events start you do not go to your child / call them to you as they will need to stay with their classes. Sometimes children do get a little upset if they do not win a race. We ask that you leave the teachers to deal with this if it happens. The teacher will find you if they think it is necessary.

Children are asked to wear a particular colour of t-shirt for their team:

Scarborough: White (their usual colour is yellow but this attracts insects!)

Clifton: Green

Lendal: Red

Ouse: Blue

Skeldergate: Purple or Black

If any parents are able to help with scoring the team activities, please let us know as soon as possible.
