Earrings

Our policy is that children need to take out earrings for PE lessons for health and safety reasons. This is standard policy in all schools. School staff cannot take out children's earrings. If your child is unable to take out their own earrings please ensure they do not wear them on PE days (detailed on class newsletters). If children are still in the 6 week window after the piercing has taken place they may leave them in but parents need to ensure that they bring in plasters to cover their earrings. We do not want to prevent children from doing this important lesson as a result of not being able to remove earrings.

Walking Wednesdays

Well done to everyone who made a special effort to travel actively to school on a Wednesday. Last week, Anderson class had the most children travelling actively to school with 91%. This week's winners will be announced on Friday in assembly.

Please remember that children must not ride their bikes and scooters on the playground or the path leading to it for safety reasons. They should get off at the school gate. Children have been reminded of this too.

Large Play Equipment

We ask that you do not let children play on this equipment before and after school. We have clear rules for using it in school times to ensure everyone's safety and we also close it when the ground/ equipment is wet or muddy. We have observed children using it in an unsafe manner before and after school and without supervision which gives them mixed messages about using the equipment. Thank you for your support with this.
