

# **Family Picnic, Sports Day and PTA Summer Fair** **Friday 14<sup>th</sup> July 2017**

Families are invited to enjoy a picnic in the school grounds from 12 o'clock. Over the lunchtime period and after school the PTA will be running the summer fair. There will be some fantastic stalls, competitions and serving drinks/ice-creams. There are some amazing raffle prizes too!

The PTA invites children to enter a **BAKE OFF** competition with a 'Summer' theme. The cakes will be sold at the end of the day and there will be some amazing prizes for the winners, including the winner's name on the Bake Off trophy.

All children who are entitled to a free school meal (all of Reception, Key Stage 1 and other entitled children) will be provided with a school packed lunch. Other children will need to bring their own packed lunch as there will be no usual lunches served on this day.

Please arrive for the picnic between 12-12:10pm, coming through the playground gates and collecting your children from the classroom door or from the area of the playground where they will be waiting with their teacher. At 12:10pm we will be locking the playground gate so please come through the main entrance after this time.

The car park will be closed so please try to walk to school if possible. If you need disabled access, please let us know and we will open the gates for you. Last year a traffic enforcement officer visited the local area and gave several cars parking tickets for blocking drives and parking illegally so please park responsibly.

The sporting events will start at 1:15pm and we anticipate they will finish just before 3pm. There will be the usual mixture of team games and races.

Once the sporting events start, please do not go to your child / call them to you as they will need to stay with their classes. Sometimes children do get a little upset if they do not win a race. We ask that you leave the teachers to deal with this if it happens. The teacher will find you if they think it is necessary.

Children are asked to wear a particular colour of t-shirt for their team if at all possible. There is no need to go out to buy a t-shirt specially. If you cannot find a t-shirt of the correct colour easily, children should wear white and we will give them a coloured sticker/band.
