Dear Parents

Children in Edison Class will be going swimming each week on Tuesday afternoons until 11th July, starting on Tuesday 25th April 2017.

They will have a 30 minute swimming lesson from 1:30pm-2pm at the Energise pool in Acomb and will travel there by coach. Children will leave school at 12:50pm and return before the end of the day.

The children will need a swimming costume (not bikinis) or trunks (not swimming shorts) and a towel. They may also wish to bring goggles. There is no need for shower gel, deodorant or money for lockers etc. It is often easier if socks are worn instead of tights and belts/ shoes with laces are avoided on swimming days as this slows down the children getting changed.

The cost of the swimming lessons is met by the school but we do ask for a contribution of £24 for the whole 12 weeks towards the cost of the coach. This works out at £2 per swimming lesson. We are asking that this is paid by 26th May 2017 through ParentPay. If you do not have your Parent Pay password, please contact the school office for a new one.

The children benefit greatly from these swimming lessons and it is such an important skill to have, especially living in this area, close to the river. Children are also required to have swimming lessons as part of the National Curriculum. Therefore, please encourage children to remember their swimming kits every week and send a note if your child is not able to go swimming.
