Our Learning

This term we will be focusing our learning on 'Animals, Life Cycles & Growing'.

The children will be involved in helping us think about how to enhance our areas of provision to reflect our exciting new topic and what they would like to learn about. Our 'Talk for Writing' in **Literacy** this term will be 'The Three Little Pigs'. Next term our learning will be centred around 'Castles and life in the past'.

Over the next term in **Mathematics** we are learning about addition and subtraction through counting on forwards and backwards, counting in 2's & 5's, capacity, shape, symmetry, estimating & position and direction.

Our **RE** topics are 'Where do we belong?' and 'What is special about our world?'

We will look at answers to these questions through different aspects of the Christian faith and touching on others e.g. Sikhism, Islam, Hinduism & Judaism.

ICT and other subjects will be covered throughout the term to fit in with the learning already mentioned.
