YOYO Visit

Tomorrow, YOYO (York Youth Trust) will be visiting school to lead whole school Collective Worship and lessons for Year 2 and Year 5 on the theme of Easter. Children always enjoy these visits and gain a good understanding of the messages from the drama and interactive activities offered.

Egg Decorating Competition: Monday 3rd to Thursday 6th April

Children are once again invited to decorate an egg (hard boiled please) and bring it in to school during next week to be displayed in the library area. Judging will take place after school on Thursday 6th so entries need to be in by the end of this day. We encourage children to do as much of the design and making as possible, using junk materials and with minimum input from adults. Each year we are so amazed by the wonderful designs and I'm sure that children will impress us again this year. Entry costs 50p (please hand in to the office or class teacher) and there will be a prize of an Easter egg for the winning design from each year group. These will be announced at the Easter Service. Please ensure that children bring a label for their egg showing their name and class.

Easter Service – Friday 7th April 9am

Children will re-tell the Easter Story and think about the symbol of the cross through drama, readings, songs and prayers led by children throughout the school. Each year at the Easter service, we present each child in Simmonds Class with a copy of a Story Bible to keep and enjoy at home. These Bibles are partly funded through a donation from St Barnabas Parochial Church Council (PCC). We hope that you will be able to join us for this service.

If children can bring in books after Easter, we will arrange a Book Swap area in each Key Stage and let the children know more about this.

Improvements to the entrance area

Over the Easter break improvements will be made to our entrance area to make the school safer. There will be a new set of secure doors just after the office window which will mean that only people who have met our safeguarding checks will be let through into the rest of school unaccompanied.
