History (Ancient Egyptians)

- Understand how knowledge of the past comes from a variety of sources
- Using dates to order/place events on a timeline.

For homework this year, I would like to concentrate on basic skills of reading, spelling and times tables recall.

To this end, I intend to give out only one piece of subject related work on a Friday, to be returned by the following Friday.

Reading: Please read with your child regularly (minimum 3 times per week if possible) and then complete one reading activity** from the list to hand in on Friday. (** if this is too much, please let me know.) Please complete the Reading Diary whenever you read with your child.

Spellings/Phonics: Your child will bring home words from our spelling activities to learn for a test on Fridays – these will be stuck in your child’s Spelling Zapper together with some useful spelling strategies.

Times Tables: We will have skills checks two or three times per week, so please help your child to learn times tables. By the end of Year 3, a child is expected to know x2,x3, x4,x5,x8,x10.

Access details to Times Tables Rockstars will be sent home this week. This is a fun, web based programme to help increase children’s knowledge of multiplication and division facts. I encourage you to have a little go yourself to see what the children need to do.
