Talk for Writing: Six Dinner Sid Story

- Hears and says the initial sound in words e.g. 'c' in 'cat'.
- Begins to read words.
- Write some clearly identifiable letters to communicate meaning. Some sounds are correct and in sequence e.g. cat.
- Recognises and writes own name and other things such as labels and captions.

Phonics Focus: All single letter sounds and names and some two letter sounds. (See separate sheets each week)
