# **English**

In English this topic we will be looking at two great authors – AA Milne and Beatrix Potter.

We will be looking at creating stories based on Winnie the Pooh and Peter Rabbit and using these to create some non-fiction pieces such as letters and instructions. We will also be looking at poetry about nature.

We are continuing to develop our skills by:

- Leaving spaces between words
- Sounding out words when spelling
- Punctuating sentences using a capital letter and a full stop
- Using a capital letter for I and names
- Joining words and clauses with 'and' & 'because'



## **Reading, Phonics and Spelling**

We will be revising all sounds and looking to link sound families together.

Please could you aim to read with your child 3 times a week and books should be brought back to school every day.

# **Art & Design**

In Art and Design for this topic we will be looking at using natural materials to create artwork. We will also be creating prints, sculptures and drawings based on the countryside and nature.

In DT, we will be looking at healthy eating and preparing and making food. We will look at where food comes from and food from around the world.

## **Science**

This topic we will be looking at animals and plants.

We are beginning by looking at humans and labelling the human body.

We will then be looking at the parts of a plant, how they grow and what they need to be healthy. We will also be learning to identify different pants and leaves.

We will also be learning to name different animals, describe their structures and identify if they are carnivores, omnivores or herbivores.

## **Topic**

Our topic this term is Great British Countryside. Within this topic we will be learning about Winnie the Pooh and Beatrix Potter.

We will look at the history of both and the impact they have had on the world.

In geography we will be comparing the countryside and the city and looking at different countries within the UK.

#### R.E

In RE this term we will be looking at the gospel and what good news Jesus brings. This will be taught by Mrs Bruce on a Tuesday afternoon.

# **Computing**

In computing this term we will be learning how to use the internet to find information. We will be looking at the history of Winnie the Pooh and creating a fact file about it. We will also be looking at internet safety and how to use computers correctly.

#### **Maths**

This term we will be covering place value to 50 and 100, measurement, multiplication and division, fractions and time. This will be covered using equipment and physical resources with an emphasis on understanding numbers in all forms.

Each day we will be having a maths meeting in order to practice our number bonds, number facts and counting. Please take any opportunity you can to count with your child and practice these facts.

We will be continuing to send out weekly maths practice for the tests each Monday. Please practice whatever is sent out with your child. This really helps improve their maths skills.

## P.E.

P.E will be taught on a Thursday afternoon this half term. Please ensure your child has a full P.E kit with indoor and outdoor shoes as the weather is still quite unpredictable!
