Talk for Writing: Owl Babies Story

- Hears and says the initial sound in words e.g. 'm' in 'mum'.
- Begins to read words.
- Write some clearly identifiable letters to communicate meaning. Some sounds are correct and in sequence e.g. mum.
- Recognises and writes own name and other things such as labels and captions.

Phonics Focus: All single letter sounds and names and some two letter sounds. (See sheets each week)
