Dr Bike will be visiting your school on Wednesday 26th February 2020

As part of our ongoing commitment to encourage active travel to school, we are running a Dr Bike day. Dr Bike is a **free safety check** intended to give you information about the safety of your child's bike. Your school's Sustrans Active Travel officer will check the bike and attach an information sheet to the bike to explain what has been checked, any minor repairs carried out and to recommend any further work that needs doing. Please note that it is not a substitute for regular maintenance/service.

Dr Bike is one of our most popular sessions. If you are happy for your child to take advantage of this opportunity please **complete and return the form below by <u>Thursday 13th February</u>. This will allow us to judge demand. Dr Bike will endeavour to get through as many of the bikes on the day as possible.**

On the day:

- Bring your child's bike to school. Please complete the label below and attach to your child's handlebars. Only labelled bikes will be checked.
- Leave bikes UNLOCKED in or next to the bike shed your lock will be closed once the bike has been attended to. Locked bikes will not be checked.

Attach this label to your handlebars, and leave your bike UNLOCKED in or next to the cycle shelter on Weds 26 th February. Dr Bike will only check labelled, unlocked bikes.
