## Where: On the playground at St Barnabas



### **Essential Information**

The children will practise their balancing, braking and general scooter handling skills through a series of activities, designed to help the children develop into more skilful and safer scooter riders.

It is important that all scooters should be in good working order. This means you need to have:

- A working brake
- Wheels in good condition (2 or 3 wheeled models are both suitable)
- A frame with no cracks on the welded joints •
- Secure handle bars, bar ends and bar plugs.

If the scooter deck is flat, deck tape should be present and in good condition.

The session is outdoors so appropriate clothing/ footwear is required. A helmet is advisory but not compulsory to take part in this activity.

#### Any child whose scooter is not considered to be safe will be unable to take part.

Places are limited to 15 per session, and will be allocated on a first come first served basis. If you would like your child to participate in the session, please fill in the form below and return to the school office by Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2020.
