Christmas Dinner and Christmas Jumper Day - Wednesday 16th December

Although the whole school can't sit down together as usual, the children will still have Christmas Dinner with all the trimmings, party hats and decorations in the hall with their usual lunchtime bubbles. There will only be a turkey dinner (or vegetarian option) served for lunch on this day. Teachers will provide activities for children to send Christmas wishes to their classmates in a different way. If cards have already been written, children can still bring them in by Monday 14th and put them in a box in the classroom. They will be quarantined and given out later in the week.

PTA Raffle

Presents for staff

Car Park

Reporting Covid cases during the Christmas break

We hope that there will be no further covid cases however, if your child develops **symptoms within 48hrs** of last being in school and then receives a positive test result please email school

stbarnabas@york.gov.uk. The DfE have asked schools to support with contract tracing for the first 6 days of the Christmas break. The school email will be checked at least once each day during this period (19th to noon on 24th December). We will be contacting any children who need to isolate as a result of contact with a positive Covid case in school (fingers crossed there aren't any!)

If your child develops symptoms **later than 48hrs of last being in school** followed by a positive test, you do not need to let us know until we return in January.

The school email will not be checked between noon on 24th December and 8:30am on Monday 4th January in order to allow school staff to have a break from carrying out Covid related work.

I understand that the bubble closures, national restrictions and changes to school routines may have been so frustrating but I feel that together we have
