Dear Parents/Carers,

We are writing to you to let you know we have been reviewing our remote learning offer and have decided to make some improvements to help all children with their learning.

The work will continue to be posted on Google Classroom for the children but we are adding in a new structure to the day and the work that is set. After the half term break all children will have a Google Meet with their teacher and class mates daily. This will be a time for the children to see each other, have an introduction to the day's work and for the teacher to give feedback on the work handed in the previous day.
