#### Improving our spelling by:

- Learning a new phonic sound every day and revising the ones we have already learned.
- Learning to spell the common exception (tricky words)
- Correcting our spellings with our purple polishing pens

### Developing positive attitudes to reading and improving comprehension by:

- Reading our phonetically matched Little Wandle books.
- Visiting the library and bringing home a book each week to enjoy
- Using these texts to help us with our writing:










# In Maths we will be developing our mathematical knowledge and skills in Reception by:


- Subitising to 5 (recognising quantities without counting)
- Securing our understanding on counting 1:1 and the final number being the total
- Counting to 5 and beyond accurately
- Looking at the parts and whole within numbers 1+3=4, 2+2=4, 3+1=4, 0+4=4 etc.
- Using mathematical language of more that, less/fewer than and equal to






# In Maths we will be developing our mathematical knowledge and skills in Year 1 by looking at:
