

Learning in Attenborough Class Spring 2023 Topics: Winter, Materials, Printing, People and their

- Using these texts to help us with our writing:









- Subitise
- Link the number symbol (numeral) with its cardinal number value.
- Compare numbers.
- Explore the composition of numbers to 10.
- Automatically recall number bonds for numbers 0-5
- Continue, copy and create repeating patterns.
- Compare length







In Maths we will be developing our mathematical knowledge and skills in Year 1 by looking at:
