- Writing sentences accurately with capital letters, full stops, finger spaces and careful spelling.
- Adding detail to our sentences by using adjectives, adverbs and conjunctions.


## Improving our spelling by:

- Applying our phonics to new words.
- Learning some of our Year 2 new spelling rules and Common Exception Words
- Learning about spelling rules for adding suffixes.

# Developing positive attitudes to reading and improving comprehension by:

- Reading our Little Wandle books with an adult to develop our decoding and fluency
- Listening to our class books including The Enchanted Wood, Lights on Cotton Rock and Beegu, discussing storylines, vocabulary, characters and predictions.
- Making links between books and identifying themes.
- Selecting books from the library to share at home.






#### In Maths we will be...

# Developing our mathematical knowledge and skills through:

- Learning about how to interpret picture graphs.
- Adding and making amounts of money with coins and notes.
- Learning to name and describe 2D and 3D shapes.
- Identifying and writing fractions (halves, quarters and thirds)
- Regular practice of our four operations addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
- Practising our number bonds and counting patterns (2s, 5s, 10s, 3s)

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# In History, we will...

- Learn who George Leeman was and why he is significant in York.
- Look at how the Leeman Road area has changed over time, including houses and shops.
- Use a range of sources to identify continuity and change including maps, photographs, oral recollections and a local walk.

## In PE, we will...

- Practice and develop our ball game skills including tag rugby.
- Develop our gymnastics skills and sequence moves together.

## In DT, we will...

- Learn about how to design and build an stable structure.
- Use DT vocabulary to evaluate our work.
