Message from Miss Boardman

Happy New Year and welcome back. The children have made an excellent return to school, showing top concentration and getting stuck into their learning after the break.

In our assemblies this week we have been thinking about our hopes, challenges and resolutions for this year ahead. The children were reminded about our expectations of behaviour. We have introduced behaviour of the week—a specific behaviour that we are looking to see (as well as all the other good behaviour of course!). For this week and next, the behaviour of the week is 'Follow instructions' (straight away).

We have introduced a new reward of 'Hot Chocolate with the Head' for children who go above and beyond with their behaviour and efforts. The first one will be held in a few weeks so we are looking out for excellent behaviours. We have also reviewed our sanctions for unacceptable behaviours such as swearing, hurting, ignoring adults, slamming doors and damaging equipment so children are clear of the amount of breaktime they will miss should they choose to show these unacceptable behaviours. This is having a positive effect so far...

Children have been reminded not to bring in items from home such as toys, jewellery as they often get lost / broken and children become upset.

Please also ensure your child is wearing a navy blue school jumper—this is our uniform expectation for all children. Please take one from our uniform shop if you need more. Children who are not in a school jumper will be given one of our spares and asked to wear it.
