Developing our writing skills by:


- Writing every day and revisiting our phonetic sounds. We also have a variety of writing activities in our continuous provision areas.

Developing positive attitudes to reading and improving comprehension by:


- Reading our phonetically matched Little Wandle books.

- Even and odd






In Maths we will be developing our mathematical knowledge and skills in Year 1 by looking at:
