Learning in Hadid Class Summer 2023 Growing plants, our wonderful world, Building mechanisms

In Science, we will...

- Observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants.
- Find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.
- Use our scientific enquiry skills to investigate how plants grow in different conditions.

In Geography, we will...

- learn about Our Wonderful World
- Identify and name most of the wonders studied including mountains, rivers and deserts.
- Compare ancient and modern wonders.

In Music we will...

- Practise careful listening and expressing preferences.
- Find the beat and produce different rhythms within a beat.
- Learn to play simple melodies on instruments.

In RE, we will...

- Learn about why some places are sacred, focussing on Christianity and Judaism.
- Why do some people think that life is a journey and what significant experiences mark this?

In PSHE, we will...

- Explore relationships including families and friends.
- Learn how to keep safe, recognise and appreciate people who help me in my family, my school and
- my community

In English we will be...

Developing our writing skills by:


- Writing for a range of purposes including a narrative based on Voices in the Park, a letter to a visitor, a character description and a set of instructions.
- Writing sentences accurately with capital letters, full stops, finger spaces and careful spelling.
- Adding detail to our sentences by using adjectives, adverbs and conjunctions.
- Writing longer pieces and building our stamina for writing.

Improving our spelling by:

- Applying our phonics to new words.
- Learning some of our Year 2 new spelling rules and Common Exception Words
- Learning about spelling rules for adding suffixes.

Developing positive attitudes to reading and improving comprehension by:

- Reading our Little Wandle books with an adult to develop our decoding and fluency
- Listening to our class books including Danny the Champion of the World, Voices in the Park and Wolves, discussing storylines, vocabulary, characters and predictions.
- Making links between books and identifying themes.
- Enjoy listening to a range of stories by different authors.






In Maths we will be...

Developing our mathematical knowledge and skills through:

- Measuring volume and capacity in litres and millilitres
- Telling the time to the quarter hour and to the nearest five minutes.
- Applying our maths knowledge to different word problems, choosing a suitable method for our calculations.
- Practising our 2, 5, 10 and 3s counting patterns and times tables.
- Regular practice of our four operations addition, subtraction, multiplication and division as well as fractions.
- Practising our number bonds and using them in different calculations.

Please help your child by practising counting in 2s, 5s, 10s and 3s at home.





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In History, we will...

- Learn who George Leeman was and why he is significant in York.
- Look at how the Leeman Road area has changed over time, including houses and shops.
- Use a range of sources to identify continuity and change including maps, photographs, oral recollections and a local walk.

In PE, we will...

- Develop our ball and racquet control in tennis.
- Develop our athletics skills through a range of summer sports.

In DT, we will...

- Learn about different joins in moving mechanisms.
- Make our own moving wheel mechanism.

In Computing, we will...

- Learn how to log on to a Chromebook, keeping our password safe.
- Learn how to safely use online learning tools such as TT Rockstars.
- Learn about and create our own algorithms to run and debug simple programs.

Learning at home:

Reading: Please read with your child at home at least 3x per week with their Little Wandle ebook and/or library book and note it in their Reading Record.

Spellings: In your child's reading record, there are a list of common exception (tricky words). Please practice these with your child. Further spellings will also be sent home later in the term.
