1. Help is here for families

Raising a family can be expensive, and with increasing financial challenges many parents find they need some extra help. We are signposting parents and carers to a wide range of local and national support as part of a new campaign to help connect families with the right financial help.

There are a wide range of benefits and support programmes that are available and you might be surprised at what you could be entitled to. Support for families include free school meals and holiday activities, help with buying school uniforms and financial support with the cost of childcare.

Anyone struggling with financial problems is being encouraged to firstly check you're receiving everything you're entitled to, reduce outgoings as much as possible, and not struggle alone.

2. Summer reading challenge

On your marks! It's time for Ready, Set, Read! the Summer Reading Challenge 2023.

The Summer Reading Challenge takes place every year during the summer holidays. Children can sign up at their local library, then read any books of their choice to collect the special stickers and rewards along the way, with a certificate and medal for all who complete the Challenge.

Children's reading can 'dip' during the holidays if they do not have regular access to books and encouragement to read for pleasure. The annual Summer Reading Challenge really helps by getting children into libraries over the summer to choose books freely and independently, and is endorsed by parents and teachers.

3. Planning a day trip over the summer holidays? Why not go by bus?

Starting on Saturday 22 July, the price of an All York Family bus ticket will be reduced to £5.50. This means that up to two adults and three children (or, one adult and up to four children) can go by bus using an All York Family ticket for just £5.50 a day, all summer holidays. You can take any bus on any route so why not use it to explore the city this summer? Your journey must start and finish within the City of York boundary.

All you need to do is buy on-board any bus, using cash or contactless payment. The ticket price will remain at £5.50 until Sunday 3 September 2023. For more information and to help plan your route, visit the iTravel website.

4. Free Holiday Activities with Food this summer

York's Holiday Activities and Food Programme (HAF) offers fun activities for keeping active, being creative, and trying something new over the Easter, summer, and winter school holidays.

Children and young people in receipt of benefit-related free school meals can receive up to four sessions of free activities and nutritious food during the Easter and winter holidays and up to 16 sessions during the summer holidays.

Each day will include: a healthy meal and a selection of activities ranging from sports, drama and creative workshops, nature activities, and much more.

The York summer 2023 HAF programme will be running from 26 July to 1 September, Monday to Friday (excluding bank holidays).

Families who are eligible to receive the HAF offer will receive vouchers from their child's school. Parents/carers will receive a voucher for each child, sent individually from their child's school.
