Our class story this week has been 'The Great Big Book of Families' and we have been learning about where we belong and sharing who is in our families.



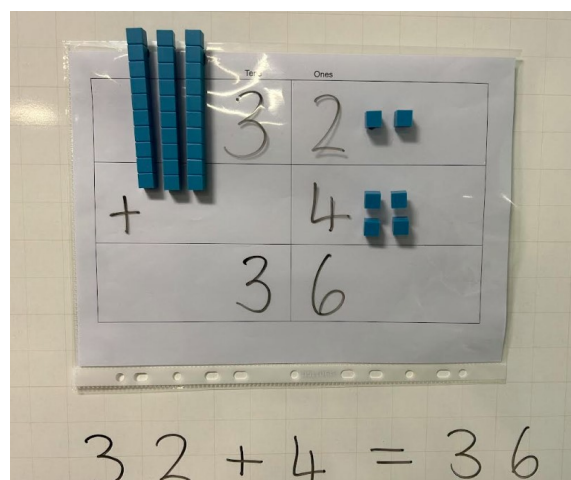
It has been lovely to see lots of children using the reading corner this week and doing some independent reading!

The Year 2s have been starting to build the foundations for column addition by using resources to represent the tens and ones while the Year 1s have been creating and solving addition number stories.



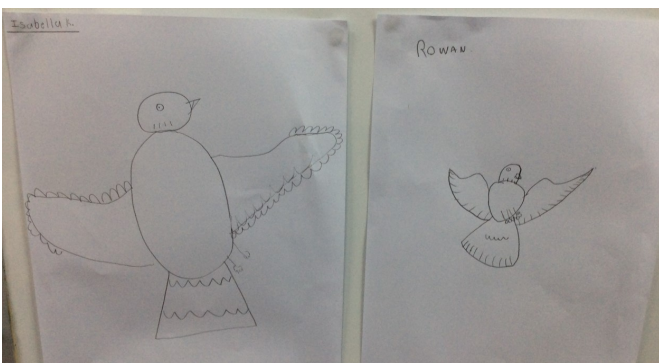

Here is our whole class photo:



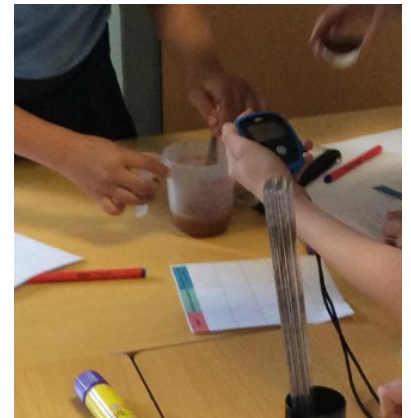
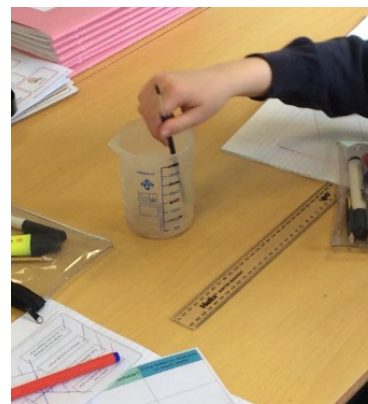
It has been lovely to see how kind and caring the children are being towards each other as we get near to finishing our first half term as Farah Class.
