### **Updated Behaviour Policy**

This half term we have revised our behaviour policy. It is available on our website by clicking <u>here</u>.

The policy sets out our rules of being 'Ready, Respectful and Safe' that we expect all children to follow. It also sets out the rewards and sanctions that are in place to help children to learn good behaviour. In Appendix 1, we have set out our expectations for the different school routines. This supports safe and orderly conduct around the school and means that everyone knows 'the St Barnabas way'. Appendix 2 shows a summary of our approach to behaviour. # Attendance

After half term, you will receive your child's attendance report for this half term. Thank you to those parents who always ensure that children are in school on time ready to learn. This really helps the children to have a calm and settled start and access all the learning that is provided for them. Being just 5 minutes late each day means that your child misses almost 30 minutes of learning each week!

After half term we are changing the way we record absence if a child is taken out part way through a school session. If this means that they miss more than half the morning or afternoon session, it will be recorded as an absence even if they have been in for registration.
